Chardonnay dominant blend, wonderful hue of silvery gold with lively tight bubbles. Baked green apple, lightly toast notes and rich pastry & brioche.

Pinot Meunier dominant blend with backup from Pinot Noir, gorgeous light blush hue, wonderful creamy red fruited palate, clean, mineral and sublime. Decanter Platinum 2020

Delicious & moreish botrytis dessert wine from the Loire Valley

- Sussex Reserve** 15
Nutbourne Vineyards, West Sussex, 2018
Crisp, dry and super aromatic, the 2018 vintage bring vibrant elderflower, gooseberry and hedgerow flowers. Unique and site-specific Sussex field blend.
- Pinot Gris** 17
Stopham Estate, West Sussex, 2018
A stellar wine from a stellar year. Plenty of stone and tropical fruit notes to savour in this eminently well produced and precise wine.
- Pinot Blanc** 17

Tuffon Hall Vineyard, Essex, 2019

Nutbourne Vineyards, West Sussex, 2018
Exceptional UK pinot noir from the 2018 harvest. A fine, light, ruby red wine bursting with red and black cherry.
- Pinot Noir** 23
Davenport Vineyard, East Sussex, 2018
*Beautiful light bodied yet flavoursome English red from the heavenly vintage of 2018. Black cherry, cranberry and redcurrant with light spice notes from reverent oak barrel age. **organic***
- Skinny Dip Amber** 28
Offbeat Wines, Wiltshire, 2018
*A robust skin-contact wine from this forward-thinking vineyard. Solaris grapes naturally fermented in amphorae produce aromas of poached, citrus zest and mint. A wine that really needs food **Organic Veg***

Our Spanish house wine, citrus & pineapple on the nose with refreshing crispness and balance from lees stirring and some neutral wood ageing
- Sauvignon Blanc Reserva** 13
Indomita, Casablanca, Chile, 2019
*Sourced from premium cool climate sites, grassy, floral, peach tones & delicate freshness **Vegan**.*
- Grüner Veltliner** 14
Funkstille, Niederösterreich, Austria, 2019
Dry with a pastiche of pear, melon and grapefruit, lovely texture and rounded feel to this fun and accessible wine
- Chardonnay** 17
Bogle Vineyards, Clarksburg, California, 2019
Sun drenched tropical fruit and integrated American oak make this a compelling food wine
- Sauvignon Blanc** 17
Cape Point Vineyards, Cape Town, SA 2020
Stunning array of vibrant tropical fruits on this new 2020 vintage, fresh and vibrant and added texture from time spent 'sur lie'
- Verdeca - only 1 left** 17
'Alice', Produttoria di Manduria, Puglia, Italy, 2019
Indigenous grape varietal that brings plenty of citrus and floral refreshment whilst delivering a mineral edge to this straw yellow wine perfect for fish or lighter dishes
- Rioja Blanco - A Veredas** 24
Bodegas Nestares Eguizabal, Rioja Baja, Spain
*Co fermented Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, this sensational was our wine of the show at the London Wine Fair 2019. Citrus & tropical pineapple with toasty oak notes **Vegan***
- Chardonnay** 22
Field Recordings, Edna Valley, 2018
Wild ferment, 8 month maturation in Acacia & US oak, golden fruit, vibrant, grip, depth & length

- Tempranillo/Syrah** 11
La Mancha, Spain, 2018
*Easy going Spanish style, balance & a great nose, rich red fruit spicy finish **Vegan***
- Pinot Noir Reserva** 13
Indomita, Casablanca, Chile 2019
*Soft and light, cherries, violets and delicate smoky nuances, bright and fresh fruit **Vegan***
- Solara Red** 13
Viile Timilsului, Romania 2019
*Merlot/Cab Sav blend, fruit-driven and complex with juicy bramble, raspberry and blackberry **Vegan***
- Malbec - only 1 left** 15
Pigmentum, Cahors, France, 2018
Each vintage seems to get better with this wine, big black fruit, rich and dark hue and good interplay between the tannin and freshness.
- Cote Du Rhone** 14
Domaine Berthete, France 2019
Plenty of warming fruit, gentle spice, medium tannin and good length, smooth and crowd pleasing.
- Barbera Di Asti** 18
Tenuta Olim Bauda, Piedmont, Italy, 2019
Classic example of the region, beautiful cherry and berry fruits that are warm and concentrated with perfect weight, balance and length
- Red Blend** 19
Thistle & Weed, Lowerland, South Africa NV
Blend of Shiraz, Tannat, Cab Sav & Petit Verdot over several vintages, powerful red fruit and wild herbs up front, gentle warming spice & elegant and satisfying depth
- Malbec** 19
Rebellion, MAAL, Mendoza, Argentina, 2018
*Superb dark fruit character, great structure & hints of chocolate, soft & smooth tannin **Vegan***
- Syrah** 26
Murdoch Hill, Adelaide Hills, Australia 2017
*Classy cool climate Syrah, plenty of succulent red fruit, subtle spice, fine tannin and medium bodied **Vega***
